MEN'S LACROSSE



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Roger Williams University junior attacker **Logan Roebuck** (Montgomery, N.Y.) helped the Hawks extend their win-streak to eight games, by notching a pair of crucial conference wins on the road this week. Roebuck tallied three goals and added an assist in a 13-4 win at Curry to open up the week, then followed up by recording five goals and five ground balls in a 12-4 win over Gordon. For the week, Roebuck was able to land 92% of his shots on frame and converted on 62% of his chances.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Roger Williams University junior goalkeeper **Tyler Roebuck** (Montgomery, N.Y.) led a stingy Hawks defense by allowing only seven shots by him on the week for an impressive 3.73 goals against average, stopping 77% of the shots he faced. Roebuck made 11 saves in 52:43 of action in a 13-4 win over Curry, and tallied 12 saves in a 12-4 triumph at Gordon.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK – University of New England freshman attacker **Tyler Thomas** (Pleasantville, N.Y.) notched seven points (five goals, two assists) in a pair of TCCC contests this week. Thomas fired in three goals in a 9-8 near upset of Gordon, then helped keep the Nor'easters TCCC playoff hopes alive with a two goal and two assist performance in a 11-1 win over Nichols. Thomas also scooped up four ground balls in each game played.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Curry College senior second baseman **Tony Luciani** (Weymouth, Mass.) batted .458 (12-for-24) with one double, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI and seven runs scored in seven games to lift the Colonels to a 6-1 weekly record and the top seed in the upcoming TCCC Championship. Luciani batted safely in seven games, including a four-game streak of consecutive multi-hit games. He also drove in at least one run in each game and scored at least one run in six different contests.



PITCHER OF THE WEEK – Wentworth Institute of Technology senior **Chris Sandini** (Upton, Mass.) tossed a six-hit complete-game shutout against eventual #5 seed Salve Regina, as the Leopards clinched the #4 seed in the upcoming TCCC Championship. Sandini struck out 10 batters in seven innings of work and walked only three.



PITCHER OF THE WEEK – Salve Regina University junior **Craig Silva** (Marlborough, Mass.) picked up a win over Eastern Nazarene and a save against Gordon — two TCCC playoff teams — and struck out 12 batters over eight scoreless innings of work as the Seahawks wrapped up the #5 seed in the upcoming TCCC Championship. Silva struck out 10 in a five-hit complete-game shutout over ENC, and fanned two batter in one inning of work against Gordon.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK – Endicott College freshman outfielder **Ralph Fideale** (Fairfield, Conn.) batted .303 (1-for-33) with seven RBI in nine games played over the season's final week. He batted safely in seven games and came up especially big in the Gulls' doubleheader split at Western New England on the final day of the regular season. In that final twinbill, Fideale batted .556 (5-for-9) with three RBI.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Curry College junior first baseman/pitcher **Amanda Peters** (East Bridgewater, Mass.) Peters batted .423 (11-for-26) with two doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI and seven runs scored over eight games played, as the Colonels wrapped up the sixth seed and one home playoff contest in the upcoming TCCC Championship. Peters, who batted safely and drove in at least one run in six different contests, swatted home runs in five different games. She also tossed complete-game shutouts over Eastern Nazarene to start the week and University of New England in the regular-season finale.



PLAYER OF THE WEEK – New England College junior third baseman **Rachel White** (Arlington, Mass.) batted an impressive .593 (16-for-27) with six doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI over eight games to lift the Pilgrims to a 5-3 weekly record, earning NEC a spot in the upcoming TCCC Championship as the #8 seed. White hit safely in seven games, including five-multi hit performances. She collected at least one extra-base hit in five different games.



PITCHER OF THE WEEK – Endicott College junior **Jenna Bortolotti** (Milton, Mass.) turned in a stellar 5-0 weekly record along with a microscopic 0.22 ERA in six starts last week. She allowed just one earned run in 31.2 innings of work, tallying 17 strikeouts and walking just three batters in the process. She logged complete games shutouts over Roger Williams, Wentworth and New England College. A winner of 17 straight decisions, Bortolotti opened the week with 27 consecutive scoreless innings.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK – Endicott College freshman catcher **Krista Fales** (Melrose, Mass.) batted .600 (6-for-10) and tallied a sparkling .765 on-base percentage over six games to help the Gulls post a 5-0-1 weekly record and lock up the top seed in the upcoming TCCC Championship.
