MEN'S BASKETBALL



PLAYER OF THE WEEK - Salve Regina University graduate student guard **Jabreche Boyd** (West Haven, Conn.) averaged 30.5 points per game on 58 % (17-of-29) shooting and 5.5 rebounds per contest in a 1-1 week for the Seahawks. Boyd drilled a career-high seven three-pointers and grabbed five rebounds in a 84-70 win over Nichols, then followed up with a career-high 35 points in a 96-85 loss to WNEC. In addition to shooting 58% from the field, Boyd went 50% (10-of-20) from beyond the arc and 71% (17-of-24) from the line on the week.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK - Colby-Sawyer College freshman forward **Jason Chevrefils** (Manchester, N.H.) recorded a pair of double-doubles and averaged 22 points and 12 rebounds in a 1-1 week of TCCC play for the Chargers. Chevrefils posted a team-high 20 points and 13 rebounds in a tough 89-79 overtime loss at Curry, then dropped a career-high 24 points and snatched 11 rebounds in a 82-73 win over Nichols. For the week, Chevrefils shot 54 % (15-of-28) from the floor and 67 % (14-of-21) from the line.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Endicott College senior center **Ceciley Chisholm** (Lexington, Mass.) averaged 25 points and posted a pair of double-doubles in two TCCC victories, as part of the Gulls' 3-0 week. She notched 21 points, 11 rebounds and four steals in a 57-44 win over Anna Maria. Chisholm also registered a career-high 29 points and 13 rebounds as the Gulls handed Wentworth its first conference loss of the year, 62-53. Chisholm also turned in 10 points and six boards in limited action during EC's 70-50 non-conference victory over Daniel Webster. In three games, Chisholm averaged 20.0 points, 10 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 2.0 steals, while shooting 51% from the field (22-of-43) and 62% from the line (16-of-26).



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK – Curry College freshman guard/forward **Julia Scrubb** (Stowe, Vt.) averaged 14.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game as the Colonels split a pair of conference matchups last week. In Curry's impressive 74-54 victory over Colby-Sawyer, Scrubb came off the bench to post a game- and career-high 23 points and a team-best eight rebounds in just 20 minutes of action. Later in the week, Scrubb chipped in six points and three rebounds in a 90-62 loss at Gordon. Over the two games, Scrubb averaged 14.5 points and 5.5 rebounds, while shooting 57% from both the field (12-of-21) and at the line (4-of-7).
